



Lloyd Boody, Palliser Regional School Director introduced himself.

Notice was sent last week to the Parent General Body, that a new Treasurer is to be elected. Job responsibilities of the Treasurer read by Ahlam Sadden. Nadia Herati was elected Treasurer by unanimous vote.

Current Account Ledger:-

- \$2,300 Balance.
- A cheque of \$600 to be paid by School Council to the school for inline skating.

Upcoming expenses this year include:

- Approximately \$1,000 deposit for Inline Skating for School Year 2019 – 2020 if it will be offered.
- Costs pertaining to the upcoming Sports Day in 2019 (approximately \$2,000)
- Graduation in June 2019 (depending on funds needed after school fundraising)

Palliser Regional School has a charitable status. If parents want to make charitable donations, they can and they will receive tax receipts.

The Principal thoroughly explained the School Calendar for 2019 – 2020. At the request of MCC, both scenarios / calendars were considered; with Mondays as half days and with Fridays as half days so that public Friday prayers (Juma) could be accommodated at the school.



Based on the School Calendar instructional hours calculations, the school will not be able to meet the instructional hours requirement by Alberta Education if Fridays were to be changed to half days since there are more Fridays than Mondays in the school year. More Mondays are off in the school year due to STAT holidays. The calculations indicate that if we have early dismissals on Fridays, the school will be short by 20 – 28 hours of instruction. The only way to meet the Alberta Education requirement and to keep the school start time and end the same is to have shorter Mondays.

After careful review, Monday half days calendar was approved by unanimous vote by all Parent Council members present. Overall calendar approval by Parent Council.

Approximately two weeks ago; the Society started public Friday prayers (Juma) @ Rehma Musallah. Hani Saleh has been requested by the Principal to look into this. He was on vacation when the Juma prayers were started at the Rehma Musallah.

Parking lot is currently having issues related to parking. People are not parking properly. We require a code of conduct / booklet. Garbage is being dumped on school premises and this is becoming a problem as well.


A suggestion was made to have the students at the school to do a video log (vlog) about all the issues that the school is experiencing. This will allow wide spread awareness of the issues at hand. The school will also issue a notice regarding parking lot issues.

Voting to be done by the Student Council whether they will allocate funds this year for the Food Drive or the Orphan Sponsorship.

More life skill programs should be incorporated into the “After Tahfeeth” program.

The after-school soccer program for Division 1 will be postponed to next year since its too late in the year to start.


